

Evans Vanodine Photography Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Organiser

The competition ("Competition") is organised by Evans Vanodine International plc ("the Organiser").

2. Eligibility

- Entrants under the age of 18 must have the permission of a parent or legal guardian to enter. By submitting an entry, the parent or legal guardian confirms that they have read and accepted these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the entrant.

3. Competition Period

- Opening date: 13 July 2026
- Closing date: 31 October 2026
- Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.

4. How to Enter

- Entry is free.
- Entries may be submitted via email or social media.
- Photographs should be submitted in JPEG or PNG format.

5. Original Work

By entering, the entrant confirms that:

- The photograph is the entrant's own original work.
- The entrant owns the copyright in the image.
- The image does not infringe the intellectual property rights or other legal rights of any third party.
- Any editing has been carried out by the entrant.

6. Consent for People Appearing in Photographs

- If a photograph includes identifiable people, the entrant must have obtained their permission before submitting the image.
- Where an identifiable person is under 18 years of age, permission must have been obtained from their parent or legal guardian before the photograph was taken and submitted.

- The Organiser may request evidence that appropriate consent has been obtained.

7. Content Requirements

Entries must not:

- Include offensive, discriminatory, abusive or unlawful content.
- Promote hatred, violence or illegal activity.
- Contain inappropriate images of children or vulnerable people.
- Invade another person's privacy.
- Breach any applicable law.

The Organiser reserves the right to reject or remove any entry that it considers inappropriate or in breach of these Terms.

8. Judging

Entries will be judged on:

- Creativity
- Originality
- Interpretation of the theme
- Technical quality
- Overall impact

The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence regarding the outcome will be entered into.

9. Prizes

- Prize details are described in the Competition announcement.
- No cash alternative will be offered unless stated otherwise.
- The Organiser reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if circumstances make this necessary.

10. Copyright

Copyright in all submitted photographs remains with the entrant.

By entering, the entrant grants the Organiser a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free licence to:

- Display the photographs in connection with the Competition.
- Publish winning and shortlisted entries on the Organiser's website and social media channels.
- Include entries in exhibitions, promotional materials and reports relating to the Organiser's work.
- Archive the entries for future reference relating to the Competition.

The entrant may continue to use their photograph for any purpose.

11. Personal Data

The Organiser will process personal information in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Personal information collected will be used solely for:

- Administering the Competition.
- Contacting entrants and prize winners.
- Arranging the delivery of prizes.
- Publicising winners where consent has been provided.

Personal information will not be used for marketing unless separate consent has been obtained.

Personal data will only be retained for as long as necessary to administer the Competition and to comply with legal obligations.

Entrants and parents or guardians have rights regarding their personal data, including rights of access, rectification and, where applicable, erasure.

12. Publicity

Winning entrants may be featured in publicity relating to the Competition.

Where the entrant is under 18:

- The Organiser will only publish the entrant's first name, age and county unless additional consent has been obtained.
- Home addresses and personal contact details will never be published.

13. Disqualification

The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any entry if:

- The eligibility criteria are not met.
- False information has been provided.
- The entry breaches these Terms and Conditions.
- Copyright infringement or plagiarism is suspected.
- The Organiser reasonably believes the Competition has been manipulated or abused.

14. Liability

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or any other liability which cannot be excluded under English law.

Subject to the above, the Organiser accepts no responsibility for:

- Lost, delayed or corrupted entries.
- Technical failures affecting entry.
- Any indirect or consequential loss arising from participation in the Competition.

15. Cancellation or Amendment

The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Terms or cancel, suspend or withdraw the Competition where necessary due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

16. Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.

Any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
